




I am pleased to announce that in this month of January, 2023 our church will embark on a new journey of learning. **The New City Catechism** is a treasure that was introduced to me last year and I am so excited about learning it together as a church. Catechism means "a summary of the principles of Christian religion in the form of questions and answers, used for the instruction of Christians." I grew up in a church that did not teach these principles in the form of catechism and I discovered it as an adult. I encourage you to download the app New City Catechism by Crossway and check it out. There are 50 questions and answers to help learn and understand who God is, why we were created and what our purpose is. The questions are



broken up into three color coded parts: 1) God, Creation & Fall, Law, 2) Christ, Redemption, Grace and 3) Spirit, Restoration, Growing in Grace.

For each question and answer, there are scriptures, songs, symbols and commentary from Bible teachers both from antiquity and the present. Especially in these times of great moral confusion, I hope you will agree with us that it is a worthy endeavor to spend time memorizing these. In Powerhouse and Youth Sunday School, we will be learning one catechism question per month...which means it will take us a while to get through all 50 but the goal is memorization not just a light overview.



In addition to the app, there is a book: The New City Catechism: 52 Questions & Answers for Our Hearts & Minds By: *Kathy Keller*.

The Christian Education Team is buying and making these books available to you for a donation of \$6. The book has everything that is in the free app, it is just in book format. Please turn your \$6 in to the offering, along with a note saying that you want one of these books and I will make sure you get one. There is also a devotional based on this catechism that looks fantastic. We have one copy of the devotional if you are interested in seeing it.

Mary Kinney will be teaching these questions and answers, scriptures and songs to our youth during Sunday School and your Powerhouse Team will be teaching the same thing to our children during Children's Church. I encourage and challenge you to memorize these questions and answers as well, and to put in the effort to learn and grow in the area of understanding our great God through his word and this excellent tool!!

Toward the goal of helping families grow in our faith in Christ, our Christian Education Team provided a **Family Prayer Calendar** to all of our families with children and youth. This is a wonderful resource that can be a blessing to your family as it gives daily prayer suggestions as well as monthly family adventure suggestions. Enjoy marking off each day as you grow in your prayer life as a family!
