Hope, Renewal and New Beginnings

Spring is a time of renewal. Birds are singing, trees and flowers are blooming, fields are turning from brown to filled with crops. Spring is also when we as believers celebrate the resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ. It is a time of hope, of new beginnings, of starting over. This looks different for everyone: some set new goals, some do deep cleaning, some follow the seasons of Lent to do away with something that was consuming their time and energy.

If ever First Presbyterian was in need of a time of hope, renewal, and new beginnings it is now. As a church family we have experienced a lot of grief and upending in the last 18 months. In August 2019 our world was shaken when Pastor Tony suffered a major heart attack. We rallied and prayed, we supported Sheri and the kids, we rejoiced with them when Tony was able to return home and when he took his first steps after that heart attack. But even with all this progress, they felt it was not the right time for Tony to return to the ministry and so we began the process of looking for a new pastor. We were entering a time of renewal.

During this time, the COVID-19 Pandemic hit. Once again, we were faced with unforeseen challenges and once again we came together as a church family. We supported each other with phone calls, texts, cards, prayers and visits on patios. Our elders stepped up to help provide worship services as we pivoted to online, recorded services. Our staff kept the office up and running, answering calls and getting needed information out as quickly and efficiently as possible. Through all of this, you, the congregation, remained faithful in your online presence and attendance, and in your giving. You supported the elders and staff through prayers and help as needed; we showed each other that we truly are a family who cares and loves one another. We were in a time of hope.

In July 2020 we had Pastor Mark Nazarian join us as our interim pastor, to help us continue to navigate the COVID-19 pandemic and all the changes happening in our world. The Pastor Search Team worked diligently and prayed fervently that God would provide us with the candidate He had chosen to lead us into the next chapter of our church's history. Pastor Tim Hoins went through many calls and interviews with the Pastor Search Team and they felt strongly that he would be that person to help us move forward. We were in a time of new beginnings.

Excitement and hope filled the church during the Christmas season. We were celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ, and the hope of a new beginning for our church with Pastor Tim leading us. Our plans are not always God plans however, and once again we were faced with unfathomable tragedy as Pastor Tim was killed in a car accident February 2021. Pastor Tim was a man who loved God and wanted to share His good news with everyone. He had just begun his ministry and had so many amazing ideas to help move First Presbyterian Church forward. Much of his ministry with us was done outside, in the parking lot, and he wasn't able to get to know and connect with everyone as well as he would have liked. He talked much about enjoying preaching, and the novelty of doing it outside, but he longed to preach inside where he could look at the congregation God had brought him here to serve. He got that wish; Pastor Tim preached one Sunday service and the Ash Wednesday service inside the sanctuary before God chose to take him home.

Now we as a church once again find ourselves facing the unknown. Once again, we are dealing with tragedy and grief and a lack of understanding, Yet, we know we serve a sovereign God, and that all things happen for a reason: His reason and purpose. As we face this new period in our church's story may we find hope and renewal during this Easter season. May we see the goodness in God's creation around us in the flowers and the trees and the growing of new crops. May we once again rally around each other in prayer and love, for we at First Presbyterian Church are a family.

Kings Gospel Mission

Kings Gospel Mission is one of our local community ministries which we support through donations of food, clothing and monetary gifts. Kings Gospel Mission has had an amazing impact on our homeless population. Listed below are some of the accomplishments from last year:

- Served 5,596 meals to overnight shelter guests
- Provided a mobile shower unit as an outreach to those living on the streets
- Housed 27 men and 9 women in Room & Board
- Opened a factory to build affordable housing

Kings Gospel Mission continues to operate a thrift store in Hanford and 2 recycling centers (Hanford and Armona). In 2021, the year long discipleship program offered to men, is to be expanded to include women desiring enrollment. Also, by partnering with Kings County, the Kings Gospel Mission broke ground (Jan. 22, 2021) on their South Hanford property to provide 24 factory built 2 bedroom houses in a "pocket courtyard" community setting. This will be an exciting process to watch. Please pray for the many ongoing opportunities that Kings Gospel Mission provides.

Partial List of Study Bibles Distributed

- 179 ESV Study Bibles total allocated for West Africa
 - 78 ESV Study Bibles allocated for East Africa
 - 78 Southeast Asia
 - 192 South Asia

Additionally: East Africa has recently seen 84 <u>third-generation</u> churches planted and 48,797 baptisms [a third generation means Church A plants Church B out of it ... and then Church B plants Church C <u>out of it</u>! Church C then becomes the third-generation church in the network].

The Nepal TTI office has now mapped 9,338 villages which is 12% of their country—so as to *strategically guide* trainees there toward launching the direction as to most quickly getting the Gospel out and the planting of new churches to the unreached areas around them.



Please keep all these leaders in prayer that the Lord will give them protection and guidance as they spread and share the gospel to the unreached! The Lord is doing GREAT things!!!








Praying for COVID restrictions to lift so we can resume planning activities.
